 - ² Undeclared Life Sciences major, previously reported in College of Letters and Science was moved to the Division of Biological Sciences in 2003-04. The totals reflect a shift of approximately 548 students.
 - ³ Of the Engineering undergraduates, approximately 342 are seeking computer science degrees through the College of Letters and Science.
 - ⁴ School of Law is based on a two term average.
 - ⁵ The Working Professional MBA and Forensic Science programs are self-supporting. All other programs are state supported, although several professional programs charge special fees.
 - ⁶ Approximately 1,566 of these students are in programs offered off campus, leaving a three quarter average on-campus population of approximately 27,556.
