<sup>1</sup> The College of Biological Sciences (CBS) was established in 2005-06. Prior to that students declared majors in either the CA&ES or Letters & Science (L&S). Existing students can remain in CA&ES or L&S or transfer to CBS. Of the total students, 3,926 have majors in CBS, 440 have majors in CA&ES, and 785 have majors in L&S.

<sup>2</sup> Of the Engineering undergraduates, 179 are seeking computer science degrees through the College of Letters and Science.

<sup>3</sup> The Design Program moved from CAES to L&S in 2005. Current students have the option to stay in CAES. This report reflects 30 students in CAES and 384 in L&S.

<sup>4</sup> School of Law is based on a two term average.

<sup>5</sup> These programs are self-supporting. All other programs are state supported, although several professional programs charge special fees.

<sup>6</sup> Approximately 1,716 of these students are in programs offered off campus, leaving a three quarter average on-campus population of approximately 27,856.
